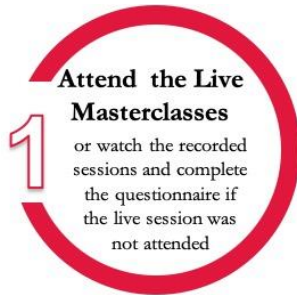

1. **CV/resume and Cover letter.** Based on the guidelines presented in this course, create your own CV or resume and write a cover letter for a potential job you would be interested in applying to. Participants who are not currently looking for jobs should still choose a potential future job to practice writing a cover letter for. We recommend sharing the cover letter and CV/resume with your mentors and/or peers so you can get feedback. You should email your cover letter and CV or resume to IMFAHE (QC@imfahe.org) as part of this course in order to get a diploma.
2. **Practice a mock interview.** Find a mock interview session or practice the interview process with your peers or mentors. In order to get the quarter course diploma you will need to email a document listing 5 potential companies or hosting labs where you would like to work and the following information: Who are they? What do they do? What is the value that you will bring to the center? to IMFAHE (QC@imfahe.org). This exercise will help you to prepare you for potential future interviews.
3. **Write and practice your elevator pitch.** Write out your elevator pitch and practice giving it to your peers. After finalizing your pitch, you will need to email it to IMFAHE (QC@imfahe.org) in order to get the diploma.
4. **Make an effective LinkedIn profile.** Register for LinkedIn (if you do not have an account yet) or log in (if you already have one), and use the tips offered during this course to create a successful LinkedIn profile. After finalizing your profile, you will need to share the link with IMFAHE (QC@imfahe.org) in order to get your diploma.
