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GREETINGS AND WELCOME FROM THE RECTOR

It gives me great pleasure to be able to welcome all the international students the University of Oviedo receives each year, as this is one of the principal activities of the Institutes of Higher Education. This 'internationalism' does not only consist of the promotion of mobility of our own students, professors and investigators towards other Centres and countries, but is also a way of gaining students from other universities in Europe and the rest of the world. The University gains a lot of prestige from this endeavour. To boost this we count on the Vice Rectorate of Internationalism and Development Cooperation which includes the International Relations Service, an administrative body that aims to help and orient foreign students.

This guide, both in print form and on line, aims to aid the incorporation of all our foreign students in the best way possible whether the students be via Erasmus or some other exchange agreement. We work towards ensuring that the student's stay here among us is a positive and rewarding one, both academically and personally. The guide contains references to both Official under- and post-graduate courses as well as the degrees issued by the University of Oviedo itself, and outlines admission to these courses. Important academic points, which should be known by all, are included, as well as information about certain university services. It also includes practical information about Asturias, transport, residence options, health care, and others of interest to the foreign visitor.

I trust that this guide will be of use to you, and will facilitate your stay at the University of Oviedo and in Asturias, and will enable you to take full advantage of it in all aspects.

1. THE UNIVERSITY OF OVIEDO

1.1. A brief historical outline

The University of Oviedo is one of the oldest in Spain and has recently celebrated its four hundredth anniversary. It began its teaching activities in 1608, its founder, Don Fernando Valdés Salas having bequeathed the university capital and incomes. The statue of this Asturian, Archbishop of Seville, Grand Inquisitor General, and President of the Council of Castille presides over the courtyard of the historical building of the University of Oviedo.

There were originally four faculties in the Asturian University. Arts, Civil Law, Ecclesiastical Law and Theology. The first stage in the history of the institution was marked by the consolidation of its teachings, academic organization and economic hardship. Then throughout the xviiith and xixth centuries the University of Oviedo gradually consolidated, renewed and widened its fields of study.

In the xxth. Century one of the most traumatic events the University lived through occurred. The October revolution of 1934 reduced the historical building to rubble, destroying the cultural heritage carefully guarded throughout more than three centuries. There then began the material and spiritual reconstruction of the University of Oviedo, in spite of the difficulties caused by the Spanish Civil War, the constraining factors of the Franco regime and the ceaseless rumours of the institution's closure.

In the democratic period following the wake of the Spanish Constitution of 1978, the University of Oviedo saw a growth in the demand for new courses. This gave rise to the inauguration of new campuses, to the construction of several faculties and to the widening of its services to satisfy the new needs resulting from the social and cultural changes Spain was undergoing. Currently, more than 28,000 students attend the University of Oviedo. The prestige of the university is well-known, due to its teaching and research in different fields: humanities, social and legal sciences, experimental sciences, medicine and technology.

1.2.2. Official Master Courses

Master courses are aimed at providing the student with specialized or multi-disciplinary studies or perhaps the beginning of investigative work. Successful completion of the courses entitles the student to the Official title of University Master. The study plans for these titles have a minimum of 60 credits, a maximum of 120 credits or two to four academic semesters.

To gain access to a Master's Course, the student should be in possession of a Spanish university degree or of one from the European Higher Education Area. (EHEA) Students with titles from organisations outside the EHEA can also gain access without the need to homologate their title as long as it shows a level of training equivalent to the corresponding Spanish titles and would allow the student access to post graduate studies in the country in which it was obtained. Students must also meet all the specific requirements and evaluation criteria for merits established in each of the Official Master's. At present, the official Master's offered in the University of Oviedo are the following:

1.2.3. Doctorate Courses

Doctorate programmes train the student in the means of research techniques through their courses or other investigative activities and include the production and presentation of the corresponding doctoral thesis, consisting of an original investigative work. Successful completion gives the student the right to the title 'Doctor'. Doctoral programmes include a training period (presently two years leading to the Title of Diploma in Advanced Studies or a Master's that provides access to a doctorate) and a period of investigation during which the student works on the original investigative work using the corresponding techniques and after its defence is awarded with the title of Doctor of the University of Oviedo.

1.3. OTHER DEGREES

1.3.1 *Own degrees*

As well as Official Titles, the University of Oviedo offers a wide range of non-official studies which are recognised both in the labour market and by Asturian society.

Master's degree

Aimed at providing a high level of training – humanistic, scientific or technical, and orientated to the professional application of this knowledge. Courses are of at least 50 credits (500 hours, theoretical and practical). Successful completion of the course leads to the title of University Master, which requires a previously gained undergraduate (second cycle) university title.

University specialist

Is aimed at the deepening of knowledge specific to scientific, technical and humanistic fields. Courses are of at least 35 credits (350 hours, theoretical and practical). Successful completion of the course leads to the title of University Specialist, which requires a previous Diploma or undergraduate degree (first or second cycle).

University expert

Is aimed at a specialization specific to scientific, technical or humanistic fields. Courses are of at least 20 credits (200 hours, theoretical and practical). The successful completion of the course leads to the title of University Expert which requires a previous Diploma or undergraduate degree (first or second cycle).

Undergraduate degrees

Commonly of long duration are designed to meet the requirements of the society not met by official degrees. They can be Own Title first cycle (at least 135 credits), Own Title second cycle (at least 90 credits) and Own Title first and second cycles (at least 225 credits).

1.3.2. *University Extension Programmes*

The vice rectorate of Extension, Culture and Sports of the University of Oviedo is in charge of programming activities such as conferences, exhibitions, courses etc aimed at promoting integral training of the university community such as the diffusion of culture and the projection of the University community in its social surroundings. One of its more relevant activities is the organisation of a wide range of Extension courses aimed at university students and at the local population. International students may also access these courses. There are offers of courses in Autumn and in Spring, but the greater bulk are the Summer Courses, normally of a week's duration, and given at a number of venues in all Asturias.

2. INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSION TO THE UNIVERSITY OF OVIEDO

2.1. Admission of students within Erasmus and other university agreements

Before arriving in Oviedo

The section on studies to be taken at the University of Oviedo must be filled in, stating the reference code and the number of credits of the subjects which the student wishes to register for. This form should be signed by the Institutional Coordinator and by the Contact Person for the Agreement at the students' home university.

Deadlines for submitting both forms:

- First fortnight of July, for students commencing studies in Oviedo in the first Semester (October to January).
- First fortnight of November, for students commencing studies in Oviedo in the second semester (February to May).

Once in Oviedo:

On arrival in Oviedo, the student must present the following documents at the International Relations Office (Calle Principado, nº 3, Planta Baja, Oviedo).

- Passport (original and a photocopy). Those students coming from a non-EU country should hold a relevant Student Visa.
- 1 passport-size photograph.
- Original and a copy of student's European Health Card or other document proving that the student has medical insurance while in Spain.
- Confirmation of enrolment for the subjects mentioned in the study contract must be sent within a period of 15 days.

To apply for the University Card that accredits them as students in the University of Oviedo, they must fill in an application form from the Information or Service Points (TPS) located in each centre, or also through this website http://ti.innova.uniovi.es/Home_2/

Students must notify any change in their address or length of stay to the International Relations Office.

Once lectures have begun:

Students should introduce themselves to each of the lecturers of the subjects in which they have enrolled and fill in the card given by the lecturers. At the end of students' stay, the University will issue a certificate of Attendance and/or Grades.

2.2. Programmes of the Vice Rectorate of Internationalism and Development Cooperation

2.2.1. *The “a-dUO” Programme*

The “a-dUO” programme attempts to make arrival in Asturias and at the University of Oviedo as easy as possible for new international students. An international student is assigned to a Spanish student from the same campus, in order to be helped with integration into the city and University life.

To enrol in the programme they must simply fill in a short form that can be found on our website: www.uniovi.es/RI/aduo to receive an email with the instructions and the name of their helper.

2.2.2. *The Tandem Programme*

Learning languages in Tandem is when two speakers of different mother tongues collaborate to improve their knowledge of the other language, culture, and to know more about the other person. The University of Oviedo organises registration at the beginning of November so foreign students and Spanish students can meet throughout the course. The most common languages are German, English, French and Italian.

For each language, one collaborator ensures s/he provides help in language tuition and those that are interested may obtain a certificate of their participation. Those wishing to take part should speak to the delegates in the Vice Rectorate of Internationalism and Development Cooperation on Campus, where they will be given detailed information and help in finding a Tandem partner. 2.2.3. *Spanish Language and Culture Courses*

The University of Oviedo offers an intensive programme of the Spanish language to students from Erasmus, Tempus, Leonardo, International Exchange Agreements, and recipients of grants from A.E.C.I.D. The intensive courses are at both Intermediate and Advanced levels, two hours daily for the duration of four weeks, and are given in El Milán, El Cristo in Oviedo and also in Gijón. These classes are wholly financed by the University of Oviedo and students need only pay registration fees and the costs of the issuing of certificates of attendance and completion.

These students may also attend translation classes: English—Spanish, French—Spanish, Italian—Spanish and German—Spanish. These courses

are held in the Milán Campus in the afternoons, from October to January, and from February to the end of May.

The University of Oviedo also offers a Course of Spanish Language and Culture for Foreigners which students may register for at a special discounted cost. The programme allows students to widen their linguistic knowledge while at the same time attaining knowledge of Spanish Culture and Society. These programmes are complemented by a number of recreative activities such as showings of Spanish films, literary competitions, photographic competitions, workshops and open days of Spanish Culture and Society, visits to places of interest, both artistic and sight – seeing

For those students with no knowledge or only basic awareness of the language, the University offers programmes of Basic Spanish for Foreigners. All these programmes require a minimum attendance of 90% to have the right to the exam and University of Oviedo Diploma.

The University of Oviedo is also the Official Examinations Centre for D.E.L.E. – a Diploma of Spanish as a Foreign Language. The exams are held in May and November, according to the Calendar established by the Institute of Cervantes. Preparatory courses for the Diplomas at Beginner, Basic and Superior levels in the three weeks prior to the exams.

3.1 European programmes

3.1.1. *Erasmus*

Erasmus is a Programme from the European Union for the co-operation in the field of higher education with the following aims:

- Support the execution of Higher Education in a European Centre.
- Improve the quality and the quantity of mobility of students and teaching personnel in Europe
- Aid the development of innovative teaching and training practices and their transfer from one participating country to others.
- Increase the contribution of Higher Education and Tertiary professionals to the innovative process, regardless of the duration of the degree, including Doctorate Programmes.

- Improve and increase multilateral co—operation between European Centres of Higher Education.

3.1.2. *Erasmus Mundus*

This is a programme of co—operation and mobility in University teaching which aims to make the European Union known for the excellence of its Inter-university Master's Programmes throughout the world. It also gives grants to students of the developing world who participate in the European post graduate programmes, as well as to European students who study in other countries.

Erasmus Mundus is concerned with:

- High level integrated Master Erasmus Mundus programmes offered by at least three universities in three different countries.
 - A system of grants.
 - Associations with higher education centres in developing countries.
- Measures that increase the attraction of higher education in Europe.

3.3. Grants awarded by the Spanish Agency for International Co-Operation for Development (AECID)***Types of grants:***

- Grants for foreign citizens to carry out studies and investigation of Hispanic culture and language. They have a duration of at least one month and a maximum of three months, according to the academic duration of the studies.
- Grants for foreigners for postgraduate studies and specializations:
 - Grants for holders of higher education titles from non Latin American countries, preferably for those from developing countries or those in transition primarily for Spanish co-operation, for doctorate programmes (Certificate/Diploma in Advanced Studies), doctoral theses (for the development, presentation and reading of theses), post-doctorate studies, Master's, Specialization courses, visits and assistanceships in Universities, Institutes and Higher public and private Spanish centres.

“Mutis” Grants are for post graduate students from the countries of the Ibero American Community of Nations, for Doctorate programmes (certificate/diploma of Advanced Studies), Doctoral Theses (to carry out, present and read the thesis.) postdoctorate studies (investigation projects), Master’s, Specialization courses, visits and assistanceships in Universities, Institutes and Higher public and private Spanish centres.

—Grants for postgraduate studies are normally for one year, but may be renewed for a second year. For courses that are longer than the period initially granted, the grant holder should seek renewal as appropriate.

Grants for foreigners for European Cultural Co—operation: these grants are of a duration in accordance with the academic studies.

4. ACADEMIC INFORMATION

4.1. Methodology and evaluation

The system of Higher Education in Spain comprises of theoretical classes, seminars and guided practice. Class attendance is not compulsory but is a fundamental part of university teaching. Students are evaluated by a final exam in February if the course is October to January, or in June for those beginning in February and annual courses. Students who do not pass this exam may retake it in September. In some cases, the professor may prefer to carry out periodical evaluations (exams, project work...) throughout the course in which case there is no final exam.

At the moment, the university is undergoing a reform to bring it in line with other European universities and the European Higher Education Area. The aim is that European universities will all be working to the same reference by 2010. The European Higher Education Area has three levels: the first level, or grade, is that which allows the holder to enter the work field with an appropriate professional qualification, and in Spain these take four years of study. The second level, postgraduate, is dedicated to advanced training and leads to a Master’s degree, which may be one or two years. The third level is the highest, and leads to the award of Doctor, after doing the first two levels and demonstrating correct investigative procedures for the elected subject.

4.2. Marking system

Marks in the Spanish Universities are out of 10, as follows:

In the University of Oviedo, marking is to one decimal point for all examined students. In addition, the professor may select 'Magna cum Laude' for the better students graded at 'excellent'. No more than 5% of the students of a subject may gain this in any one academic year.

4.3. Academic Calendar

The academic year at the University of Oviedo begins on the 1st of October and ends on the 30th September of the following year. There are three holiday periods: Christmas, Easter and summer. The basic organisation that is in force for the official titles of first and second cycles is established by the length of studies and which are split into 2 four-month periods, though there are subjects which take one year and obviously cover both four-month periods:

First four-month:

From the first week of October to 31 January,
Exam period: the first fortnight of February.

Second four-month:

From the second fortnight of February to the second week of June.
Exam period: from the second week in June to the second week of July.

The first fortnight of September is a period for exam retakes.

5. UNIVERSITY SERVICES

5.1. Accommodation

5.1.1. *Rented flats and family stays*

The International Relations Service provides foreign students with help in finding accommodation, with their database of rented flats and host families. It is not possible to reserve a room in a rented flat in advance. Students interested in this option should reserve a room in a hotel, hostel or boarding house for the first few days of their stay and upon their arrival in Oviedo should go to the International Relations Service to register and consult the corresponding database. Monthly rents for a room in a shared flat range from 180 to 220 euros, whereas board and lodging with families costs around 525 €.

5.1.2. University halls of residence

The University of Oviedo has a limited number of places available in Halls of Residence. They are allotted strictly in order of request, and so must be reserved well in advance. Prices vary according to the residence chosen. The price per month per person for an individual room is around 463 €. A double room is around 375 € per person per month. Postgraduate students should pay around 510 € per month.

This building was completely renovated in 1991. It has 59 single rooms and 20 double rooms.

All the rooms have their own bathroom, built-in wardrobes and a desk (two desks in the double rooms). The Hall is mixed (both men and women). The Hall has a library, a T.V. and Video room, a computer room and a meeting room. Residents have free access to all the University sports facilities (indoor swimming pool, gymnasium, tennis—court, sports complex, running track, football pitch, etc.), the Hall in fact being situated in the midst of these facilities. The Hall has a self—service facility, a cafeteria, and a restaurant, which are open every day of the week. The reception—desk is open 24 h. a day every day and rooms are cleaned daily.

6. PRACTICAL INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

6.1. The Principality of Asturias

The Principality of Asturias is one of the 17 Autonomous regions of Spain. It is in the north of the country, on the coast, protected by the Cantabrian Mountain Range, and forms part of the Cantabrian coast together with Galicia, Cantabria and the Basque country, also known as 'Green Spain'. The climate is basically that of the Atlantic – mild temperatures and abundant rain throughout the year which brings about a rich and varied vegetation. The most important examples of this are the 'Bosque de Muniellos', and the National Park of Covadonga. There is also an important network of rivers which flow fast with deep currents and lakes and lagoons, such as those of Covadonga and Saliencia. Its land is varied with three main zones: high mountains formed by the Cantabrian Mountain Range where you can find the high European Peaks such as Torre Cerredo, 2,646m. and the mythic Naranjo de Bulnes, 2,519m. The second is the interior mountain range with narrow valleys, fields, meadows and woods which lead down to the coast, the third zone, the coast, rocky with numerous cliffs and beautiful beaches and estuaries such as those of Llanes, Ribadesella and Villaviciosa.

Its culture is steeped in antiquity: prehistoric paintings in the caves of Tito Bustillo, Candamo... thermal baths with Roman remains in Gijón, Celtic forts such as that of Coaña, pre-romanesque monuments such as the churches Santa Maria del Naranjo, San Miguel de Lillo, San Julian de los Prados and

Santa Cristina de Lena. There are also artistic Roman monuments such as the monasteries of San Salvador de Cornellana and Santa Maria de Valdediós, and also Gothic – the Cathedral of Oviedo. There are around one million one hundred inhabitants, unequally spread over its seventy eight municipal centres, with the majority living in Gijón, Oviedo and Aviles. The city of Oviedo, in the geographical centre of Asturias, at the foot of the Naranco mountain range is a mixture of urban life style and wonderful monumental patrimony – testimony to its rich historic past. It is the capital of the Principality and the administrative, political, commercial and cultural centre of the region. The majority of the University centres can be found in Oviedo, while the largest urban area is in Gijón, on the central part of the Asturian coast. Gijón is a dynamic, tolerant city, a nucleus of industry and service industries, with commercial and sporting ports, five beaches, and an intense cultural life with many museums and sports centres. Other important urban areas in the region are Aviles, Mieres, Pola de Laviana, Cangas de Onis, Sama de Langreo and La Felguera...

And if we add to this mixture of beautiful nature and extensive historic remains, the art and culture of Asturias the vitality and hospitality of the Asturians as testified by their music, dances, fiestas and processions, you will see how attractive the region is and how much it merits visiting.

6.2. Connections with Asturias

By Air:

The airport of Asturias is in Ranón, in the region of Castrillón, 45 km from Oviedo, 40 km from Gijón. There are regular flights to Madrid, Barcelona, La Coruña, Tenerife, Palma de Mallorca, Malaga and Alicante. There are also flights to London and Paris. For more information, call the number of the airport which figures at the end of this guide. Regular flights have a bus service to both Oviedo and Gijón which have good transport systems so students should have no problems reaching their pre-arranged lodgings.

By Train:

There are main train stations in Gijón, Oviedo and Aviles as well as in most areas. For information on services offered, lines, prices and so on, call either RENFE or FEVE (narrow gauge line), numbers are in the guide at the end. From these stations one may take a bus or a taxi.

By Bus:

There are a number of bus companies that connect Asturias with other Spanish or foreign cities. Again, the phone numbers for the two largest, ALSA and TURRYTRANS can be found at the end of this guide. The bus stations have interurban bus stops and taxi ranks nearby.

By Car:

The National road 634 (N634) communicates Asturias with Irún, the Basque country and Cantabria, and the N604 links Madrid with Asturias.

6.3. Medical care

Foreign students from member Status of the EU, Iceland, Lichtenstein, Norway and Switzerland, may obtain medical care (Social Security) during their stay here in Spain and receive the same benefits as Spanish students. They should, therefore, apply for the new European Medical Card from the Health Authorities in their home country and present an original and its copy together with their passport or identity card in any Social Security centre in Spain. If you have any doubts regarding students' medical insurance, please contact the Instituto Nacional de la Seguridad Social at their offices in Calle Santa Teresa de Jesús 8 y 10, 33005 Oviedo. Telephone numbers: +34 985 107821, 900166565, or consult their website: www.seg-social.es

Students from non EU countries may also obtain medical care if there exists a reciprocal agreement between their own country and Spain: Andorra (indefinite), Chile, (2 years maximum), Brazil (maximum 1 year), and Ecuador (maximum 1 year). They should apply in their home country for the relevant medical form, and present this together with a copy and their passport in any Social Security Centre.

Foreign students who are not covered by the above should take out some kind of private medical insurance.

6.4. Student residence permit

All students and Professors whether from EU countries or not, must request the corresponding permission to stay in the country.

6.4.1. *Students from the EU and European Economic Area:*

Students and Professors from EU member states, or from states who are part of the Agreement of the European Economic Area, holders of a valid Identity Card or Passport and who are going to reside in Spain for more than three months should ask for the corresponding 'Registration Certificate as a Community Resident'.

Documents required:

- Application form Ex 16, original and copy.
- Valid passport or ID card. If these have expired, you need to present a copy and the request for renewal.
- Proof of payment for the costs of this certificate, except in cases where the applicant holds a NIE issued prior to this request.

6.4.2. *Students from non EU countries:*

Non EU students/professors, who will be staying in Spain for more than six months and whose study visa does not cover this period should request an 'Extension of Stay for Studies or Investigation' before arriving in Oviedo.

Documents required:

- Application form Ex11, original and copy
- Full valid passport or ID card
- Proof of registration on the course (first renewal), or that the holder has passed the required exams to continue his/her studies or investigation (second renewal)
- Proof that the person has the economic means for their stay in Spain.
- Proof that s/he has medical insurance to cover his or her stay including medical bills and repatriation costs in case of an accident or medical emergency.
- 3 photos passport sized, colour with a white background.
- In the case of minors, parental or tutorial permission.

6.5. Cost of living, food and transport

6.5.1. Cost of living

Monthly bills for a university student may be between 500 and 550 euros a month. There is no limit to the amount of money a foreign student can bring into the country. We recommend students use a credit card and open a bank account when they arrive. To open a bank account, it is necessary to have a N.I.E. (Identification number for foreigners living in Oviedo) which can be obtained from either a local Police Station, or the Oficina de Extranjeros, completing the necessary forms.

6.5.2. Food

Although the University of Oviedo does not have dining halls, faculties and University schools have cafeterias which offer sandwiches, rolls, and hot dishes for between 3.5€ and 5.5€. Near to the faculties and in the centre of town there are numerous restaurants that offer a wide range of Asturian dishes from approximately 6€.

6.5.3. Transport

There is a regular bus service between Oviedo and Gijón, with buses every 15 minutes until 22.30. These buses leave from the ALSA bus stations at the following addresses:
